Purpose

Organizing these resources into a formal curriculum will allow residents to take more full advantage of these opportunities and will prepare the next generation of physician leaders from the Moran Eye Center.

Format

- We will have one-hour sessions on the first Tuesday of every month from 5:30-6:30pm.
- Tacos will be provided.
- These sessions will incorporate all of the non-clinical sessions that the residents are expected to attend.
- The sessions should be interactive. Potential formats include, but are not limited to: journal clubs, panel discussions, group activities, flipped classroom, etc.
- Each session will have a course leader. The course leader will plan the session.
- The sessions should not be identical year-to-year, the session leader should discuss with the current residents to focus on a topic that is relevant and timely.
- This curriculum will dovetail with Moran's Resident Research Curriculum created by Dr. Eileen Hwang
 - Incorporated Resident Research Curriculum will including the regularly occurring sessions:
 - October Research Works in Progress
 - April Prep for Resident Research Day
 - July and December Journal Club
- This curriculum will be on a 3-year cycle and updated every 3rd year to adapt for changing needs/resident preferences
